








Mission and Impacts


Potential Topics to Consider for Global Collaboration

- Identify actionable next steps, aligning efforts with NDC updates and enhancing coherence between NDCs and LTS.








- Develop a Green Hydrogen Roadmap by 2025
- Developing regulatory enabling conditions for hydrogen market
